

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DEEP FORD LANE, CHETNOLE

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along DEEP FORD LANE, CHETNOLE between its junction with Dunch Lane to the Ford, a distance of 25 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 3 October 2022 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 21 October 2022.

This Order will enable Shire safe access for drilling and constructing cantilever buttresses.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Back Lane - C93 - Yetminster Road
