

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C93, LEIGH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along C93, LEIGH between the entrance to Park House Barn and a point approximately 70 metres north east. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 01 November 2023 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 07 November 2023.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out emergency works to replace communication pipe relay.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Yetminster Road - Melbury Road - High Street - C45
