

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHETNOLE ROAD, LEIGH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along CHETNOLE ROAD, LEIGH between its junction with Back Drove and Brookside, a distance of approximately 75 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 10 January 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 January 2024.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out a service disconnection.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Yetminster Road - Melbury Road - High Street - Brister End - C45
